TROPHIES

Each passing entrant will receive a BTCA rosette. Prizes will be given for each dog achieving their title.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

1. No dogs under 6 months of age will be allowed to enter.
2. No bitches in season will be allowed to run. Entry fees paid for a bitch that comes into season will not be refunded.
3. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred by the Test Committee. No entry fees will be returned if the Test cannot start or be completed due to an Act of God or any cause beyond control of the Test Committee.
4. The owner or handler entering a dog in these Tests does so at his or her own risk and agrees to assume responsibility for any damage caused by him/her or by his/her dog. He/she also agrees to abide by all rules set forth in this Premium list.
5. Barking dogs outside the Test Area are to be removed from the area but not disciplined for barking.
6. No dog will be allowed in the Test Area until his or her judging time.
7. Lunch break will be at judge's discretion.
8. **USE OF FLEXI-LEADS WITHIN TEST/TRIAL PRECINCT IS PROHIBITED.** The test/trial precincts are within 100 feet of the test/trial area.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

Coming East Bound or West Bound on I-20, take the Cisco Exit and head South on Highway 183. Pass through Rising Star and May. Approximately 7 miles South of May, turn left onto FM 1467. Go 2.2 miles and Raveneaux Ranch will be on the right hand side of the road. There is a large ram's skull on the gate and a wooden sign that says "Johnson". Coming from Austin, take Hwy 183 North through Brownwood to FM 1467 and turn right and go 2.2 miles and it will be on the right.
